

Mid-Atlantic ministry video being filmed at Liberty Baptist

The cameras will be rolling during the Sunday morning service at Liberty Baptist on July 12th as members and guests, who have graciously consented to participate, approach the altar in sacrificial humility. In a demonstration of Christ-like compassion for the ever-growing numbers of children and families being added to the ranks of the poor and needy, they will remove and leave their shoes at the altar.

The video will be used to promote “Barefoot Sunday”, a ministry event being conducted by Shoes 2 Share International. Hundreds of churches throughout Delaware, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Maryland and Virginia will be encouraged by the video presentation to participate in the ministry officially scheduled to take place on Sunday, November 1, 2009.

Participating churches will be asked to collect these and all other shoes being donated that day and deliver them to nearby, centralized drop-off sites. Volunteers and staff of Shoes 2 Share will collect and process the “Barefoot Sunday” offering. The shoes will then be returned to their home state and delivered to prequalified ministries and organizations for distribution to the needy. These programs will assist the many Americans who have lost their jobs due to company shut-downs or workforce downsizings.

A portion of the shoes collected in Delaware will go towards the “Thanksgiving Partnership Program” being spearheaded by Shoes 2 Share. This collaborative project with a national media broadcasting company, corporate sponsors and compassionate people throughout our state will provide food, clothing, shoes and other needed commodities to the families of those who have lost jobs as a result of the 2009 auto assembly plant closings and others experiencing the devastating effects of the economic downturn.

Pastor Tuten and the entire Liberty Baptist leadership request a rousing response of participation to the altar call on July 12th. All types and sizes of shoes will be accepted. It is recommended that you bring an additional pair of shoes to wear back home.
